Notice of Special Event Order
Thame 10K Road Race
Date of Event: 25th June 2017

Notice is hereby given that on the 12th June 2017 Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make an order to facilitate the holding of the annual Thame 10k Road Race on Sunday 25th June 2017, which is promoted by Mr Rod Lavers, Thame Runners, c/o 19 Conigre, CHINNOR, Oxon, OX39 4JY. The Council is satisfied that it is not appropriate for the event to take place wholly off road. The effect of the order is to temporarily prohibit any vehicle from proceeding:

- a) between 9:30 and 10:30am on 25 June in the B4012 Thame Eastern Bypass between its junctions with the A4129 Kingsey Road roundabout and the B4445 Chinnor Road; and
- b) between approximately 9:25 and 9:45am in Oxford Road from High Street to the A418 roundabout.

Exemptions are included for emergency services, emergency works, and for vehicular access to adjacent premises which are only accessible from the closed sections of road.

The alternative route for traffic affected by the B4012 closure is via Kingsey Road, East Street, Park Street, Chinnor Road and Garden City & vice versa. There is no alternative route for the Oxford Road and High Street closures.
