

PTR Report for Planning/Environment Meeting 04.04.17

I attended the PTR meeting at County Hall Oxford on 28th February 2017.

An OCC officer reported that the Council are still supporting community transport by providing driver tuition; looking at developer 106 support for bus services and developing a more regular relationship with bus companies. He suggested that an operator be invited to a future PTR meeting, which everyone thought was a good idea.

There was a lot of discussion about the Comet service and it was agreed that an officer dealing directly with the service be invited to the next meeting.

Toby Warren from Community First Oxon gave a presentation on Community Transport Filling the Gap (full details in the minutes of the meeting attached – Section 11).

At the end of this week I plan to contact Witney Town Council to arrange a meeting to find out more about the town bus service they have set up recently.
