Purpose of the Report

1. To approve the renewed Thame Youth Memorial and Council Partnering Agreement.
2. To consider a Council nomination for the Thame Youth Memorial Trust (TYMT) as a Trustee (as another external organisation). Reporting to into the Policy and Resources Committee.

Background

3. The Council and the TYMT five year Partnering Agreement signed in April 2012 to oversee the installation, funding and management of the area expired on 3 April 2017.
4. The attached Partnering Agreement has been amended to reflect the future maintenance requirement and the roles responsibilities of both parties for a further five years.
5. TYMT have requested formal Council representation.
6. The amendments have been developed and discussed with the TYMT Trustees, who have agreed and signed both agreements for Council approval.

Resource Appraisal

7. No additional resource requirements have been identified with this Partnering Agreement, except the formalising of an external organization representative.

Risk Assessment

8. Attached, as appendix 2, is an assessment of the risks that need to be considered before entering into the agreement. Members should be satisfied that the level of risk and measures taken to mitigate any impact on the Council are acceptable.
