PUBLIC FOOTPATH THAME No 13  
PUBLIC FOOTPATH STOPPING UP ORDER 2014**



The above Order was made on 18 December 2014. The effect of the Order will be to divert the footpath described in Schedule 1 to this notice as shown on the Order map.

Any representation about or objection to the Order may be sent or delivered in writing addressed to the Democratic Services Manager South Oxfordshire District Council, Benson Lane, Crowmarsh Gifford, Wallingford, Oxon OX10 8ED not later than 19 January 2015. Please state the grounds on which it is made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, South Oxfordshire District Council may itself confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

**SCHEDULE  
PART 1**

Description of site of existing footpath path (A – B as indicated on the map)  
Path to be extinguished

The whole width and entire length of Public Footpath, Thame No 13 commencing at Grid Reference SU 7205 0514 (Point A on the Order Plan) and running generally eastwards for a distance of approximately 203m metres to Grid Reference SU 7225 0513 (Point B).

**PART 2**

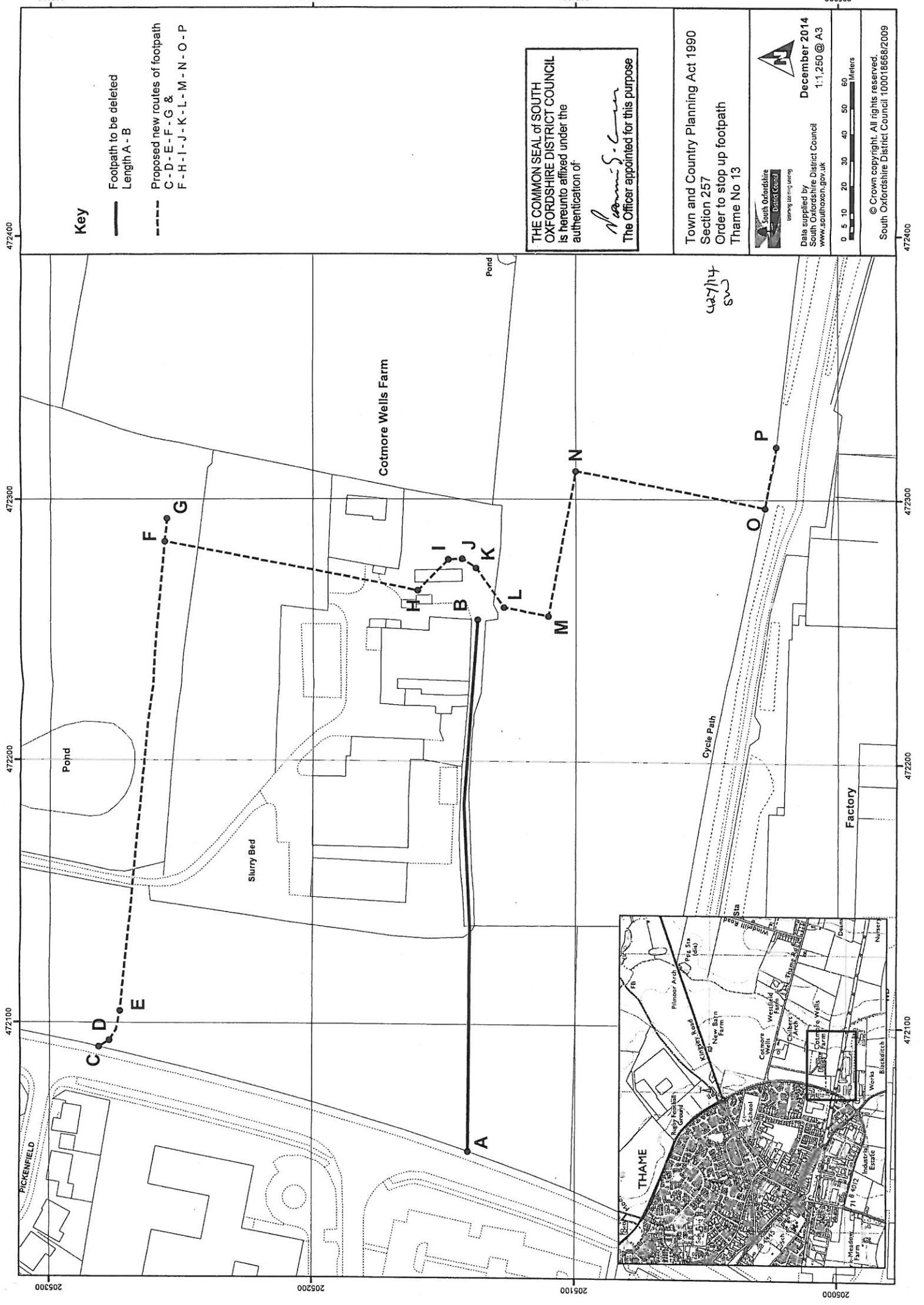
Description of site of alternative footpaths (C – D – E – F – G & F – H – I – J – K – L – M – N –  
O – P as indicated on the map)  
Paths to be created

A Public Footpath with a width of 1.8 metres commencing at Grid Reference SU 72091 05281 (Point C) running south-eastwards for approximately 5 metres to Grid Reference SU 72093 05277 (Point D) then heading east-south-eastwards for approximately 12 metres to Grid Reference SU 72104 05273 (Point E) then generally eastwards for approximately 198 metres through Grid Reference SU 72283 05256 (Point F) to Grid Reference SU 72292 05255 (Point G).

A Public Footpath with a width of 2.0 metres commencing at Grid Reference SU 72283 05256 (Point F) running south-south-westerly for approximately 98 metres to Grid Reference SU 72265 05160 (Point H) then south easterly for approximately 17 metres to Grid Reference SU 72276 05148 (Point I) then southwards for approximately 5 metres to Grid Reference SU 72277 05143 (Point J) continuing south-south-westwards for approximately 6 metres to Grid Reference SU 72273 05138 (Point K) continuing south-westwards for approximately 18 metres to Grid Reference SU 72258 05127 (Point L). Then continuing southwards for approximately 17 metres to Grid Reference 72255 05110 (Point M) before running easterly for approximately 56 metres to Grid Reference SU 72310 05099 (Point N), then running southwards for approximately 73 metres to Grid Reference 72296 05027 (Point O) then running easterly parallel with the Phoenix Trail cycleway for approximately 23 metres to Grid Reference SU 72319 05023 (Point P) where the footpath joins the Phoenix Trail cycleway.

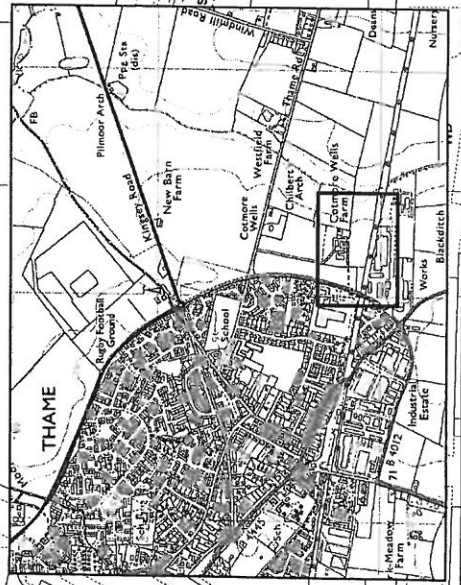
