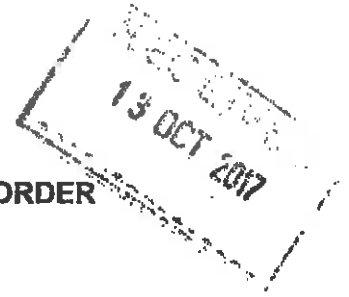

NOTICE OF MAKING A PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER

The above Order, made on 9 October 2017 under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 will extinguish the full width of the public footpath commencing at Grid Reference SU 7205 0514 (Point A on the Plan) and running in a generally easterly direction for approximately 202 metres to Grid Reference SU 7225 0513 (Point B on the Plan) as shown on the Order Map.

NOTICE OF MAKING A PUBLIC PATH CREATION ORDER

(Footpath at Cotmore Wells Farm, Thame)
Public Path Creation Order 2017**

The above Order, made on 9 October 2017 under Section 26 of the Highways Act 1980 will create a Public Footpath with a width of 2 metres commencing at Grid Reference SU 72090 05291 (Point C) running south-eastwards for approximately 14 metres to Grid Reference SU 72093 05278 (Point D) then heading east-south-eastwards for approximately 12 metres to Grid Reference SU 72104 05274 (Point E) then generally eastwards for approximately 196 metres through Grid Reference SU 72291 05255 (Point F) to Grid Reference SU 72299 05254 (Point G) and a Public Footpath with a width of 2 metres commencing at Grid Reference SU 72291 05255 (Point F) running south-south-westerly for approximately 57 metres to Grid Reference SU 72280 05199 (Point H) continuing in a south westerly direction for approximately 33 metres to Grid Reference SU 72262 05172 (Point I) then heading in a southerly direction for approximately 61 metres to Grid Reference SU 72256 05111 (Point J) continuing generally eastwards for approximately 42 metres to Grid Reference SU 72297 05105 (Point K) then southwards for approximately 77 metres to Grid Reference SU 72296 05028 (Point L) before running easterly parallel with the Phoenix Trail cycleway for approximately 24 metres to Grid Reference SU 72319 05024 (Point M) where the footpath joins the cycleway.

This Order is made by South Oxfordshire District Council ('the authority') under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to the authority that the footpath described in paragraph 1 below is not needed for public use.

Oxfordshire County Council has been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public rights of way over the land situated at Cotmore Wells Farm off Howland Road, Thame and shown by a continuous bold line on the plan contained in this Order ("the Order Plan") and described in the Schedule to this Order shall be extinguished on the date upon which Oxfordshire County Council Certify the South Oxfordshire District Council (Footpath at Cotmore Wells Farm, Thame) Public Path Creation Order 2017.
2. The making and confirmation of this Order shall be concurrent with the making and confirmation of the South Oxfordshire District Council (Footpath at Cotmore Wells Farm, Thame) Public Path Creation Order 2017.
3. This Order shall be cited as the South Oxfordshire District Council (Public Footpath, Thame No 383/13) Public Path Extinguishment Order 2017.

This Order is made by South Oxfordshire District Council ('the authority') under section 26 of the Highways Act 1980 ('the 1980 Act') because it appears to the authority that, having regard to the matters set out in section 26(1), there is a need for a public footpath over the land to which this Order relates, and that it is expedient that the paths should be created.

Oxfordshire County Council has been consulted as required by section 26(3) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. There shall be on the date of confirmation a public footpath ('the Footpath') over the land at Cotmore Wells Farm, Thame described in part 1 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold broken line on the Plan attached to this Order ('the Order Plan').
2. The making and confirmation of this Order shall be concurrent with the making and confirmation of the South Oxfordshire District Council (Public Footpath, Thame No 383/13) Public Path Extinguishment Order 2017.
3. This Order shall be cited as the South Oxfordshire District Council (Footpaths at Cotmore Wells Farm, Thame) Public Path Creation Order 2017.

DESCRIPTION OF LAND

A Public Footpath with a width of 2 metres commencing at Grid Reference SU 72090 05291 (Point C) running south-eastwards for approximately 14 metres to Grid Reference SU 72093 05278 (Point D) then heading east-south-eastwards for approximately 12 metres to Grid Reference SU 72104 05274 (Point E) then generally eastwards for approximately 196 metres through Grid Reference SU 72291 05255 (Point F) to Grid Reference SU 72299 05254 (Point G).

A Public Footpath with a width of 2 metres commencing at Grid Reference SU 72291 05255 (Point F) running south-south-westerly for approximately 57 metres to Grid Reference SU 72280 05199 (Point H) continuing in a south westerly direction for approximately 33 metres to Grid Reference SU 72262 05172 (Point I) then heading in a southerly direction for approximately 61 metres to Grid Reference SU 72256 05111 (Point J) continuing generally eastwards for approximately 42 metres to Grid Reference SU 72297 05105 (Point K) then southwards for approximately 77 metres to Grid Reference SU 72296 05028 (Point L) before running easterly parallel with the Phoenix Trail cycleway for approximately 24 metres to Grid Reference SU 72319 05024 (Point M) where the footpath joins the cycleway.
