Purpose of this Report

1. To provide a verbal / written update on the plans to convert Priest End Allotments to Burial Space.

Update

- 2. Identified s106 monies of around £26,000 relate to various developments around Thame (The Elms (£3,341), Site F (£18,335 on 75th occupation), Thame Service Station (£1,806) and Angus House (£2,630.33 received by SODC)). SODC has been informed that the Town Council is forward spending these s106 funds.
- 3. Further landscape and clearance works have been undertaken to the site at a cost of £493.40, but still within the available s106 monies. To date a total of £12,054.10 has been spent on the scheme.
- 4. The land was formally transferred to the diocese of Oxford on the 6 November 2017.
- 5. On the 14 December 2017 the Rt. Revd. Colin Fletcher OBE, Bishop of Dorchester consecrated the land in preparation for the use of burial by the church.
- 6. Officers will continue to assist the church in the final landscaping requirements for the area in line with available funding.
