Purpose of this Report

1. To provide a verbal / written update on the long term lighting solution at Southern Road Recreation Ground car park.

Update

2. A lighting design scheme has been submitted by Abacus Lighting. The lighting scheme conforms to BS5489 - Lighting for Car Parks. The lighting can be controlled by time clock or photocell and this facility will be operated from the restricted access boiler room within the changing rooms. The company can also provide ongoing maintenance support to the lighting columns should this be needed.
3. Identified s106 monies for community safety at Southern Road Recreation Ground of £16,362.67 relate to the development of land north of Oxford Road P14/S3841/FUL (15S30 and 15S31). This funding has been received by SODC from the developer.
4. An application for the s106 funds was submitted to SODC on 19 December 2017 and has been reviewed by Officers at SODC. The Countryside Officer had concerns regarding light spill into Cuttle Brook Nature Reserve and as a result of these concerns a back spill shield will be fitted to the light column adjacent to the area and this additional fitment will be a condition of the funding.
5. The cost of scheme is £17,411.25 + VAT. The remaining difference in funding of £1,048.58 will be drawn from the Capital Receipts Reserve as agreed at Full Council on 17 January 2017.
6. The lighting contractors visited the site on 21 February 2018 to undertake a final survey of the site and electric supply from the changing rooms. At this visit they advised that the possible installation dates are w/c 5 or 12 March with works being completed within 1 week of commencement. The contractors will have access to the changing rooms for welfare facilities. The 3 parking spaces adjacent to the changing rooms will be cornered off for use as a site compound. Parking spaces adjacent to Cuttle Brook will also be cornered off to allow for trenching works as there is limited access to this area and will be available for use as soon as work permits in this section. The car park will remain in use during this work other than those areas detailed above. The work will not affect any football bookings.
