Update

2. Cllrs Midwinter and Bretherton, as Mayor of Thame Town Council and Chairman of South Oxfordshire District Council respectively, have been working behind the scenes organising the event. Currently, a bouncy castle and the Royal British Legion Poppy Appeal Stall have confirmed attendance.
3. The Red Kite Family Centre, OX9er's, RAF Air Cadets and Army Cadets have agreed to assist with operational requirements at the event. Dependant on available space the Army Cadet Assault Course will be on site, as well as a bouncy castle.
4. Donations are being sought to assist with event costs and advance tickets will be sold by the Information Centre and on the day by the Red Kite Family Stall.
5. On the day at 3pm "The Nations Toast to the Heroes of WW2" will take place by a representative from Thame Players.
6. Operational support is being given by the Community Services Manager to organise the road closure equipment, agree the event layout and produce a risk assessment. The Road Closure Application, which will be in the name of the Town Council and public liability will be submitted to South Oxfordshire District Council imminently.
