Notes

*The Mayor (Ann Midwinter) and Deputy Mayor (Paul Cowell) are Ex-Officio members of all Committees and as such one or the other is often on Mayoral duties at the same time as the various Council / Committee meetings. Cllr Bretherton is a District Councillor and currently the Chairman at SODC and similarly is often on civic duties.
