## Quarterly Report to Thame Town Council on the work of the Red Kite Family Centre

The impact of the pandemic on all our lives has continued in recent months and this has been just as true for the Family Centre as it has for the local schools and other early years settings in the town. During the autumn season up until Christmas the centre staff team only had 5 days when all were able to work normally. For the rest of the time there was always at least one staff member unable to work because of a personal covid infection or because of isolation with a family member infected. This presented enormous challenges to our two acting leaders Catherine and Helen. Thanks to their supreme efforts and the 'can do' spirit of the staff team, relief staff and volunteers, only a very small number of sessions had to be cancelled and the centre was able to keep its programme up and running for local families.

We now have 250 families registered with the Family Centre and most of these are attending one or more sessions on a regular basis. During January 2022 attendance at all sessions at the Thame centre ranged from 71% to 106%\* (\*Some overbooking is allowed to cover last minute cancellations). The most popular sessions remain our twice weekly 'stay and play' sessions. Attendance at our 'Outdoor Explorers' sessions at Moreton Barn Farm have been lower during the winter months but we expect this to grow significantly as the warmer weather arrives.

In January our new Family Centre Manager, Sarah Candy began working with us and she has been working hard getting to know the staff team, building relationships with them and all our families. She will be arranging a meeting with Linda Emery our council representative very soon. It is already making a big difference having a complete staff team. This will also enable us to grow our outreach work to new families in the coming year
