4. Event requirements are underway with RAF Halton, contracted SIA Security and Town Council Maintenance Team to assist with road closure implementation. Southern Road Recreation Ground Car Park will be closed to the public for the duration of the event.
5. The costs and the responsibility for holding the event are with the Town Council. Officers are working within the agreed budget set, with all risks regarding the event assessed accordingly.
