Purpose of the Report

1. To approve the renewed Thame Youth Memorial and Council Partnering Agreement.

Background

2. The Council and the TYMT five year Partnering Agreement signed in April 2017 to oversee the installation, funding and management of the area expired on 25 April 2022.
3. The attached Partnering Agreement has been reviewed with no amendments required to reflect the future maintenance requirement and the roles responsibilities of both parties for a further five years.
4. The reviewed Agreement has been discussed with the TYMT Chairman and Trustees, who have agreed and signed both agreements for Council approval.

5. No additional resource requirements have been identified with this Partnering Agreement, except the formalising of an external organization representative.
