#### Update


2. Buckingham Palace has announced further details on the ceremonial, celebratory and community events that will take place over the Coronation weekend between 6 – 8 May 2023. https://www.royal.uk/coronation-weekend-plans-announced

Saturday 6 May – Coronation service in Westminster Abbey, Coronation procession; Buckingham Palace balcony.

Sunday 7 May – Concert and lightshow at Windsor Castle, Coronation Big Lunch street parties.

Monday 8 May – Extra bank holiday, Big Help Out encouraging people to get involved in local volunteering.

3. The Town Council has held a survey to find out how residents and community groups would like to commemorate the Coronations: 81 responses were received.



## Projects for consideration

- a) On Sunday 7 May 2023 between 2pm-6pm organise a street party in front of the town hall or on Southern Road Recreational Ground inviting the food stalls and entertainment. Subject to staff commitment.
- b) Encourage holding street parties and provide the advice for residents to celebrate with their neighbours as promoted for the Queens Platinum Jubilee.
- c) Planting of fruit or nut trees on Council sites subject to approval from the Open Spaces Working Group after seeking expert advice, location/s, and partnership working with the Thame Trees / Thame Green Living Plan who are already working on different areas within Thame. Or to assist with encouraging the community to take part with planting in their gardens.
- d) Plant one of the raised flower beds at the Memorial Gardens at a cost of £695, which would be delivered and planted on 5 June 2023 after the Coronation in May. The cost would be £695.00 + VAT.

Alternatively, both raised planters at the Memorial Gardens are planted with a red, white and blue flowering scheme created by the Operations Manager and Maintenance Team within planting budgets.

e) Encourage all community groups to promote their activities on Monday 8 May 2023.

- f) A budget of £5,000 has been approved by the Council.
- g) The planting scheme at the Memorial Gardens would be £695 +VAT for delivery and planting w/c 5 June 2023.
