Long Service Awards – Officers/Staff

- 1. The Town Council values its staff and the service they give to the people of Thame.
- 2. When staff members remain loyal to the Town Council and work for significant periods of continuous employment, it is appropriate to make a suitable award to the member of staff concerned to demonstrate the council's appreciation for their loyal service.
- 3. 5 years of continuous service is rewarded with 5 days additional holiday entitlement¹; Which starts from the April following the work anniversary.
- 4. Any serving member of staff will be entitled to a long service award of an e-gift card. The benefit value will be processed via payroll and is not pensionable as it is not classed as earnings but as a gift and will be subject to tax if amount exceeds HMRC allowances. When tax is applicable Thame Town Council will increase award by 25% to enable the staff member to benefit from the award increments agreed below:

For 10 years' continuous service - £100 For 20 years' continuous service - £200 For 30 years' continuous service - £300 For 40 years' continuous service - £400 For 50 years' continuous service - £500
```

5. A certificate will be presented by the Town Mayor as close to the relevant anniversary as possible.

Standard Holiday Entitlement as of July 2023: 25 days holiday plus public holidays.
