### Purpose of Report

1. To provide background for a decision on a minor change to the Civic Regalia – to enable the Mayor's Consort wearer to have the flexibility to display their Badge of Office by the ribbon or a pin brooch/badge.

### Background

2. The Mayor has researched an improvement to The Mayor's Consort Civic Regalia to provide flexibility to the holder on how to display their Badge of Office, either by pinning directly onto a garment or worn around the neck via the ribbon. The diagram below shows the minor adjustment to enable this change.
3. The Community Services Manager has sought permission regarding this minor change from the descendant family who presented the Mayor's Consort Badge of Office.



### Resource Appraisal

4. The minor change will be executed professionally, and a quote for £395 has been established from a local jeweller. This would come from the Civic Regalia budget.
