This application relates to the placement of removable furniture on the pavement at the front of our business premises (a café and a deli). The stretch of pavement that will be used is 4m to 4.4m wide.

A lane for on-street parking borders the pavement and separates the road traffic from the pavement kerb.

The furniture will be sited immediately outside the premises and will leave a clear width of 3m to 3.4m along the pavement, between the furniture and the kerb.

There are no lighting columns, litter bins, road signs or other existing street furniture within, or near, the licensed area.

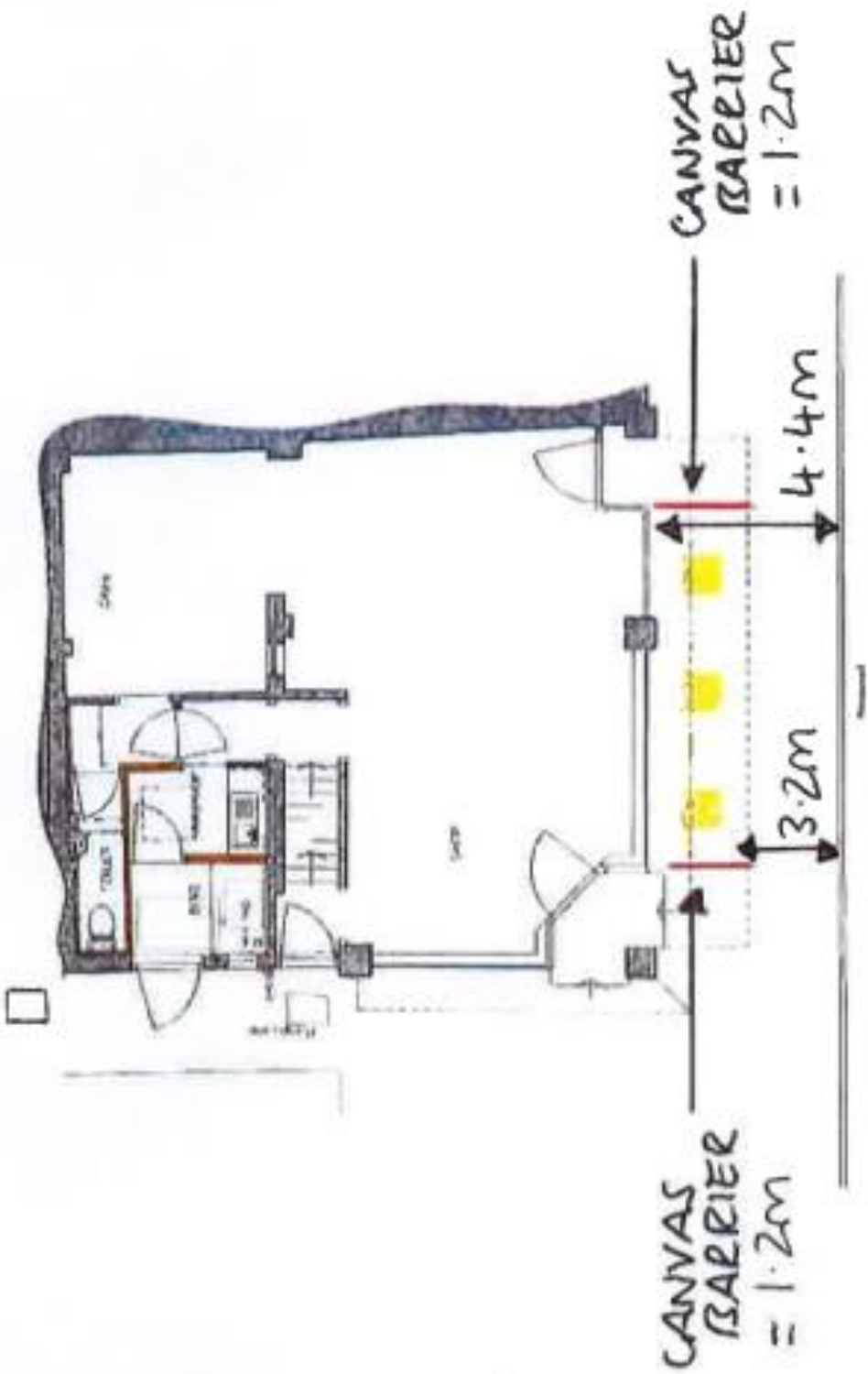
Bolero chairs with wooden-effect frames, wicker seats, and rubber feet – quantity 12 (4 at each table).
