

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(THAME AND VARIOUS PARISHES) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2023**

The Oxfordshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Thame and Various Parishes) (Speed Limits) Order 20** and shall come into force on the day of 202*, and variously includes parts of the Parishes of Great Haseley, Great Milton, Postcombe, Thame, Tiddington with Albury and Tetsworth.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
4. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.
5. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4 to this Order.
6. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
7. The Oxfordshire County Council (Thame and Various Parishes) (Speed Limits) Order 2023 hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE 1

20mph Speed Limit:

Thame

The whole length of every road in Thame (excluding any lengths of road specified in schedules 2, 3 or 4) extending in the case of the respective roads leading out of the town to the following points:

a)	B4445 Aylesbury Road	a point 60 metres north of its roundabout junction with Bell Lane & the B4445 North Street
b)	B4445 Chinnor Road/Garden City	a point 25 metres southeast of its junction with Cotmore Gardens
c)	Cheshire Road	its junction with the B4012 Howland Road
d)	Cromwell Avenue	its junction with the A4129 Tythrop Way
e)	Fanshawe Road	its junction with the B4012
f)	Kingsey Road	a point 40 metres east of its junction with Kings Road
g)	Oxford Road	a point 15 metres southwest of its junction with Fish Ponds Lane
h)	Pearce Way	its junction with the B4012 Howland Road

l)	Thame Park Road	a point 15 metres south of its junction with Chowns Close

e)	B4445 Chinnor Road/Garden City	from a point 25 metres southeast of its junction with Cotmore Gardens, south-eastwards	to its roundabout junction with the B4445 Chinnor Road
f)	Blackmore Close	from its junction with Youens Drive, westwards	for its entire length
g)	Churchill Crescent	from its junction with Kingsey Road, northwards	for its entire length
h)	Dormer Road	from its junction with the B4012 Wenman Road, northwards	to its junction with the B4445 Chinnor Road/Garden City
i)	Jane Morbey Road	from its junction with Thame Park Road, westwards	for its entire length

j)	Kingsey Road	from a point 25 metres east of its junction with Kings Road, eastwards	to a point 50 metres west of its roundabout junction with the B4012 Howland Road
k)	Lupton Road	from its junction with the B4012 Wenman Road, northwards	for its entire length
l)	Orchard Close	from its junction with Kingsey Road, northwards	for its entire length
m)	Oxford Road	a point 15 metres southwest of its junction with Fishponds Lane, south-westwards	to a point 35 metres east of its roundabout junction with the A329 & A418
n)	Stages Road	from its junction with Jane Morbey Road, southwards	for its entire length
o)	Station Yard	from its junction with Thame Park Road, eastwards	for its entire length
p)	Thame Park Road	from a point 15 metres south of its junction with Chowns Close, southwards	to a point 215 metres south of its junction with Wenman Road
q)	Town Farm Close	from its junction with Oxford Road, northwards	for its entire length
r)	Youens Drive	from its junctions with Jane Morbey Road, northwards	for its entire length.

Moreton

a)	Judds Lane	From a point 200 metres south of its junction with the unnamed road (running south-westwards) to Elmfield House, north-east and south-eastwards	for a distance of 775 metres
b)	Road from the A329 to Moreton	From its junction with Judds Lane north-westwards	for a distance of 75 metres
c)	Unnamed road to Elmfield House	South-westwards	for its entire length
d)	Un-named road	From its junction with Judds Lane	to its junction with Thame Road
e)	Un-named road	From its junction with Judds Lane, north-eastwards	for its entire length.

Towersey

a)	Chinnor Road	from its junction with Thame Road south-westwards	for a distance of 555 metres
b)	Church Lane	from its junction with Thame Road	to its junction with Lower Green.
c)	Lower Green	from its junction with Church Lane north-westwards	for a distance of 92 metres
d)	Manor Road	from its junction with Chinnor Road south-eastwards	for a distance of 445 metres
e)	Thame Road	from its junction with the Chinnor Road	to a point 474 metres northwest of its junction with Windmill Road.
f)	Windmill Close	from its junction of Windmill Road	for its entire length.
g)	Windmill Road	from its junction with Thame Road northwards	for a distance of 367 metres

40mph Speed Limit:

Thame

a)	A329 Rycote Lane	from a point 44 metres southwest of its junction with the A418, south-westwards	to a point 425 metres west of its junction with Moreton Road (partly in the Parish of Great Haseley).
b)	A4129 Kingsey Road	between a point 22 metres southeast of its roundabout junction with the A418 Aylesbury Road and	a point 80 metres east of its roundabout junction with the B4012.
c)	B4012 Howland Road	from its roundabout junction with A4129	to a point 42 metres northeast of its roundabout junction with B4445 Chinnor Road.
d)	Kingsey Road (west)	from its roundabout junction with the B4012, westwards	for a distance of 50 metres.

e)	Towersey Road	from its junction with B4012, eastwards	for a distance of 47 metres.

a)	A418 (Thame to Tiddington)	From its junction with the A329, Thame, westwards	to a point 250 metres east of Ickford Road, Tiddington.
b)	A418 (Tiddington towards Wheatley)	From a point 340 metres west of its junction with Sandy Lane, Tiddington, westwards	To its junction with the A40, Great Milton.

- 3) A329 Milton Common to Thame - in the Parishes of Thame, Great Haseley and Tetsworth.

A329 (Milton Common to Thame)	from a point 118m northeast of the A40 London Road, north-eastwards	to a point 425 metres west of its junction with Moreton Road, Thame.
